University Fours Marshals - Wednesday

The Senior Umpire today will be: **Derek O'Brien**. He will be by the A14 Bridge coordinating starts. In an emergency, you can contact him at 07770 518675.

It is VERY IMPORTANT that every college provides marshals as indicated by this rota. If you fail to provide a marshal as indicated, you will be fined and asked to produce more marshals. If colleges don't provide marshals, we simply can't run the races! And we only ask for marshals from colleges who have boats entered in the competition. Please arrive at the indicated place on time.

Wave 1 of Races

Marshals in this section need to meet at 13:30 at the Railway Bridge (except the boat marshal). If you are late (which you really shouldn't be) you may need to meet us at the little bridge. You need to wear a bib if you are marshalling. I'll leave these at the finish marshal's area for you to collect.

Boat Marshal: (Peterhouse) This person will only need to arrive at 2:10pm and start pulling in crews at peter's posts/Chesterton. Send off all the crews once the previous wave has finished. You will need to stay from 2:10pm-about 3:10, when the third wave is sent to the start.

Wave 2 and 3 of Races

Everyone here will need to be at the railway bridge by 2:15pm. Bike Marshals need to cycle to the finish and obtain a bib from the previous bike marshal at men's finish (railway bridge). The bike marshals will need to cycle on the **meadow side** up to the women's start (bottom of reach) and cycle with the crew to the finish (Chesterton). Finish marshals need to meet the previous finish marshals at 14:30pm, just below the railway bridge. You'll be done by about 4pm. The start umpire will need to record the time of each start, and also formally start each race. You do this by making sure the boats are lined up, and the coxes are happy, then make a roll call, and call: attention; go.
