## University Fours Marshals - Friday

The Senior Umpire today will be: **Derek O'Brien**. He will be by the A14 Bridge coordinating starts. In an emergency, you can contact him at 07770 518675.

It is VERY IMPORTANT that every college provides marshals as indicated by this rota. If you fail to provide a marshal as indicated, you will be fined and asked to produce more marshals. If colleges don't provide marshals, we simply can't run the races! And we only ask for marshals from colleges who have boats entered in the competition (attempting to be proportional to the number of boats you have entered). Please arrive at the indicated place on time.

## **All Races**

Marshals in this section need to meet at 13:30 at the Railway Bridge (except the boat marshal). If you are late (which you really shouldn't be) you may need to meet us at the little bridge. You need to wear a bib if you are marshalling. I'll leave these at the finish marshal's area for you to collect.

**Start Umpire (SU)**: (Derek O'Brien of Magdalene)

**Start Marshal 1**: (First and Third)

Bike Marshals 1, 2, 3: (Caius), (LMBC), (Downing)

**Finish Marshal 1 (SU)**: (Julian Granger-Bevan of Selwyn) You need to be aware that the finish line will be changing quite a bit for this. Take a look at the summary for the day beforehand. I will try to allow a bit more time between the M4+ and the M4- for you to change your position.

Finish Marshal 2: (Andrew Norman of Pembroke)

**Boat Marshal**: (Queens) This person will only need to arrive at 2:00pm and start pulling in crews at Peters Posts for 2:10pm after collecting a bib. Send off all the crews once the three men's races have finished. There will be only 2 women's races after this (finishing at Chesterton), so you need to then pull in the 2 men's crews for the M4+ final at Chesterton, out of the way of the women's finals. Once you have sent off the Men's final crews, you are done.

Friday will be a very important day, and so everyone will need to be extra sharp to keep up with what is going on. There will be some close finishes. Julian will be judging all finishes, as there are no Selwyn crews racing, and so hopefully everyone is satisfied that he is impartial.
