VENUE: National Water Sports Centre, Nottingham, NG12 2LU

ELIGIBILITY: These Championships are open to students at institutions in membership of BUCS, who meet the

eligibility regulations. BUCS online entry forms must be authorised by your Athletic Union

President or the Sports Officer and NOT another club official.

ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis up to a safety limit to be confirmed by

the organisers.

ENTRY FEES: £9 per seat

N.B. Due to the ever increasing cost of staging the regatta, the entry fee has been raised from £8

to £9 per seat this year. Coxes remain uncharged.

ENTRY FORMS: All entries should be made via Fixtures Live. Online forms will need to be completed in full -

incomplete forms cannot be submitted.

CLOSING DATE: Online Entry will automatically close at midnight on Thursday 15 April 2010.

LATE ENTRIES: The online entry system does not allow for late entries to be submitted.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to competitors finishing in the top three places in each event. BUCS

Points will be awarded to the top six places for boats with 8 or 4 athletes and top four places for

boats with 2 or 1 athletes in Championship categories only.

The Victor Ludorum will be awarded to the top Institution at the end of the regatta. All categories

are eligible for VL points.
