General info

City boathouse will be open from 9:30 for crews to collect numbers and pay for entries, where this hasn't been done in advance.

Races will be run in blocks of approximately 10 races. All crews in each division should be marshalled downstream of the stake boats at least 5 mins before the division start time.

Crews boating from boat houses on the course should be ready to boat immediately after the last race of the division before the one in which they are racing has finished but no boats should be placed on water until permission to do so has been received from the marshals or via the PA system.

After racing crews should proceed upstream of the Fort St George bridge and should not pass through the bridge on their way back downstream until indicated to do so by the marshals.

As the course is run round a bend, the start will be staggered, and masters handicapping will be applied to masters and alumni events.

Please obey the instructions of marshals and umpires at all times.

Prizes

Prizes are offered for all events (even straight finals).

For finals held in divisions 1 to 5, competitors may collect their prizes throughout the day from City boathouse, at any time after the final race of each event. There is no need to wait until the end of the day.

For finals held in divisions 6 to 11, there will be a prize giving presentation at the end of the day.
