University Fours 2018

Thank you for your entries to the University Fours. The draw and race timetable are now available here: http://www.cucbc.org/uni_fours. All crews should carry lights for the row home on every day of racing. For their first race of each day, all coxed fours should marshal between Baitsbite lock and the start line at the time shown on the website, paired up with their opposition. Friday only: The M4- should marshal at the Railway Bridge and wait for the SFs to finish before proceeding down to the lock. Winners of the SFs should make their way back down to the lock as soon as the course is clear, and pair up with their opposition down there. Crews will start ~120m apart, with 2 start lines and 2 finish lines. The stations have been randomly allocated and cannot be changed; they are shown on the draw and race timetable. All competing clubs are required to provide marshals, the rota for which is below. Failure to provide your allocated marshals will result in your club not being allowed to compete, as marshals are essential to the safe running of the event. Marshals should be senior rowers or coxes, will need a bike, and should meet at the Railway Bridge at the start of their slot. Substitutes, providing they would have been eligible crew members before entries closed, will still be accepted until 17:00 on Sunday 21st Oct (by emailing committee@cucbc.org). After that point, crews will be fixed, and substitutes will only be accepted in a case of accident, injury or illness.
