

Cantabrigian Rowing Club



Cambridge Winter Head Saturday 18th November 2017

Held under the Rules of British Rowing – British Rowing Rules of Racing will apply.

Course: 2,500 metres from the A14 by-pass to Stourbridge Common.

Boats: Eights and fours (4-, 4+, 4x, 4x+)

Events: BR: Senior, Masters, Junior
CRA: Senior, Masters, Junior (*Closed Events*)
Student: College1, College2, Beginner (*Closed Events*)

We are normally oversubscribed. Priority will be given to BR entries, with remaining spaces allocated to CRA and Student entries in the order in which they are received. All entries must be fully paid for. To be most certain of getting entries accepted, place them in BR events or, failing that, get them in early.

BR events: Use the new BROE2 online entry system

All crew members must have British Rowing membership. Events will be split into bands containing crews of similar ranking. Masters events are initially listed as MasA - we will create age-based banding according to entries received. Please contact us if you wish to enter a Junior event which is not listed.

CRA events: Use the CRA entry form from the Cantabs website

Available to clubs affiliated to the Cambridgeshire Rowing Association. Senior entries will mirror the BROE2 system, with crews declaring the total number of PRI points or old regatta based points. We will create a mapping between the two. Events will be split into bands containing crews of similar ranking.

Student events: Use the STUDENT entry form from the Cantabs website

Available to university and college crews. It is left to the clubs to decide whether their crews are College1 or College2 according to whether they are broadly first boat standard or below. A crew may only enter the Beginner event if none of the crew (cox excepted) rowed before September 2017.

- Masters events will be run using the British Rowing handicap timing system.
- Doubling up is allowed.
- British Rowing membership insurance is only valid for UK residents who are resident in this country for more than six months in a year.

Division times: (D1) 8.30am, (D2) 10.15am, (D3) 11.40am, (D4) 1.05pm, (D5) 2.30pm

Prizes: Engraved hip-flasks will be awarded to winners of events with 3 or more entries. Pennants will optionally be awarded to junior events.

Fees: Eights: £80, Fours £40

Entries: Entries close 4pm Saturday 11th November 2017.
The draw will be performed at the address below on Sunday 12th November.
