Marshals should meet at the **Railway Bridge** at the start of their shift. Marshals in the 15:30 shift on Wednesday may have to wait until after the Novice Races have finished before being briefed.

Clubs which fail to provide marshals risk having their entries **disqualified**, as we cannot run safe (or fair) racing without marshals.

Novice races will be run side-by-side along the reach, all other races will be run from the posts downstream of the A14 bridge to the posts downstream of the railway bridge.

The Mixed Double Sculls and Women's Pairs have exactly 3 entries each, and so both of these events will be run as a straight 3-way final.
