WHAT IS CLARE NOVICES' REGATTA?

- Four events
 - Men's Cup, Women's Cup
 - Men's Plate, Women's Plate
- Format of racing
 - Straight knockout race run in divisions
 - Standing start
- Rules available on clareboatclub.org.uk





RACE COURSE

• Approx. 800m, side-by-side, upstream





MARSHALLING ARRANGEMENTS



• First division will row down to plough reach without stopping at Chesterton



STATIC MARSHAL LOCATIONS





RACING – BEFORE THE RACE

- Do not proceed on the race course unless instructed by a marshal
- Side-by-side upstream on the Long Reach
- Before your race
 - Have your crew come to frontstops
 - Raise one hand, lower your hand as soon as ready to go
 - Listen to the marshals
 - 'Jesus.... Selwyn.... Attention GO!'
- Mind the wind





RACING – DURING THE RACE

- Stay on your side!
 - Be aware of the wind
 - Short, sharp whistle followed by calling your college = get back on your side
 - Failure to heed this warning will result in disqualification
 - Safety first
- Continuous whistle blast from umpire = you <u>MUST</u> stop your boat!!
- Avoid tunnel vision





RACING – AFTER THE RACE

- Morley's Holt = finish (short foghorn blast)
- Finish = bow ball crosses the finish line
- Once you pass the finish line, <u>KEEP ROWING</u> to clear the course
- If you win, follow marshals' instructions
 - you might have to pull in at P&E if racing in next division
- If you lose, keep rowing home
- Prize collection at Clare Boathouse after event





HEALTH AND SAFETY

• <u>SAFETY FIRST</u>

- Bow balls, lifejackets, heel restraints
 - You cannot race without these we will be checking!
- Brief crews on appropriate clothing
- Common sense & courtesy
- Lights if you're racing in the last div or if poor visibility





HEALTH AND SAFETY

- <u>SAFETY FIRST</u>
- ARA guidelines all participants have a duty of care!
 - Act in a manner that will not compromise the safety of themselves, Club members, other water users and the general public
 - Assess risks and base their decisions on such assessments
 - Be proactive in warning others of impeding danger
 - Inform coaches of any medical conditions that present risk to yourself/crew/other water users



OTHER INFORMATION

- Bank parties
 - Min. 1 bank party (senior boat club member), max. 4 bank parties
 - Bank parties must stay behind relevant Junior Umpire
 - No whistles, loud-hailers etc. permitted
- Race Packs
 - One person from each college to collect the race pack from the Clare Boathouse on Friday (will be in a box by the entrance of the boathouse)
 - Check that it contains coxes instructions, timetable of racing, circulation pattern, race numbers, safety pins
